



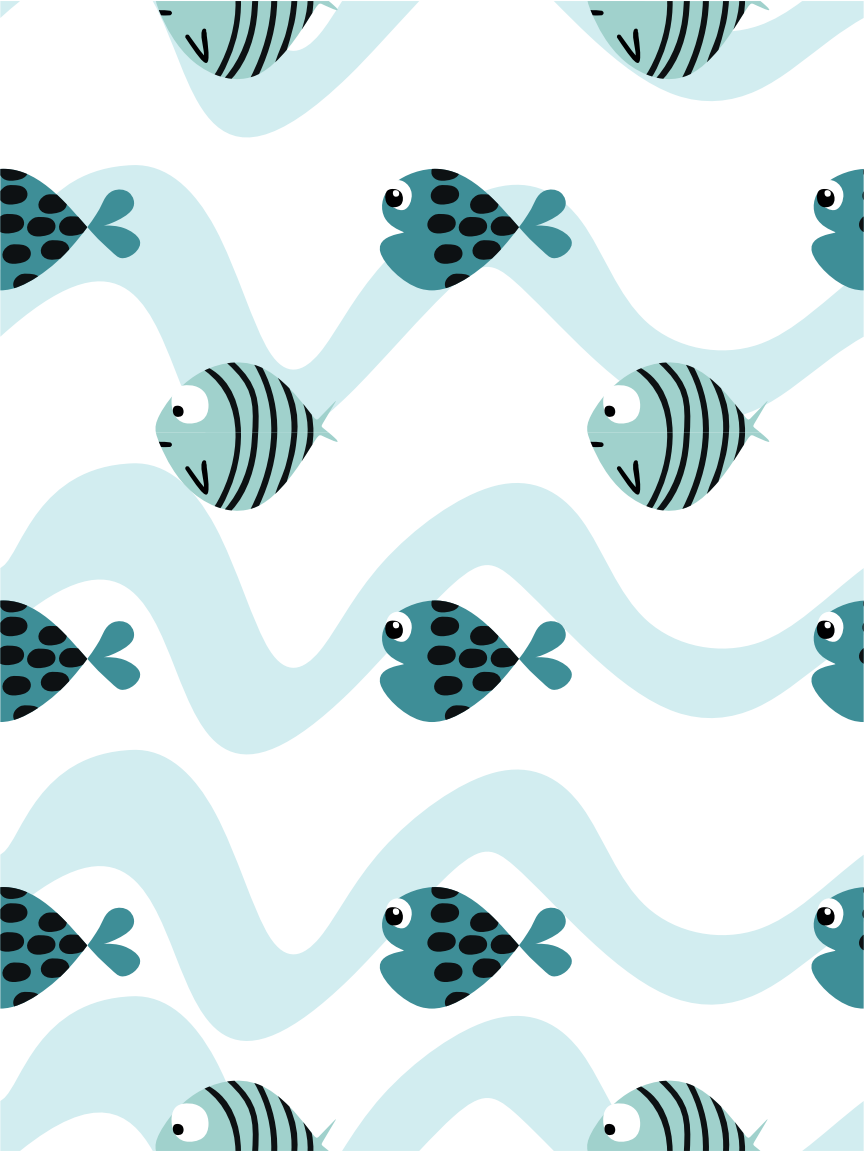

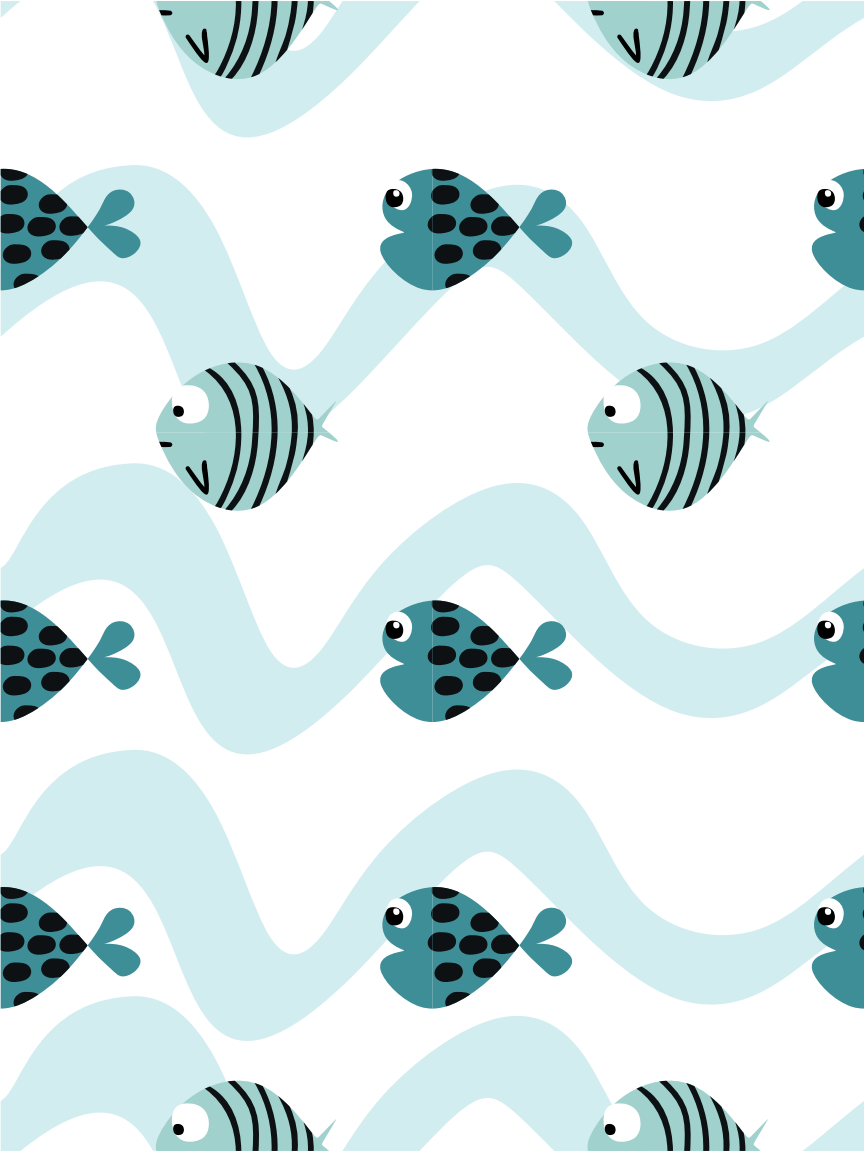




Preface
